## Bible Study Worksheet: Lesser-known Women of the Bible

1. Spiritual seers mentioned in the Bible were both male and female. Huldah was a prophetess who “dwelt in Jerusalem in the college.” Please name the king of Judah who consulted Huldah concerning the book of the law found in the temple. *II Kings 22:1-20*
2. Miriam the prophetess took a timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances, according to the book of Exodus. Please name Miriam’s two brothers. *Exodus 15:20-22*
3. In the book of Genesis we can read the story of Tamar. Her first two husbands (who were brothers) die before she has children. She ends up having twin sons who are fathered by her father-in-law. Please name Tamar’s father-in-law, one of the twelve sons of Jacob. *Genesis 38:-130*
4. A wise woman from the city of Abel negotiated with Joab regarding a plan to save her city from destruction. Joab was the military general for a powerful king. Please name this Hebrew king. *IISamuel 20:15-22*
5. When Jesus was a baby, his parents took him to the temple in Jerusalem. Two older people at the temple immediately recognized that Jesus was the promised Messiah. One was named Simeon. Please name the prophetess who gave thanks unto the Lord for Jesus. *Luke 2:25-39*
6. A woman named Rahab lived in Jericho. She cooperated with the Hebrews by hiding some spies. Please name the leader of the Hebrew people who arranged for Rahab and her family to be spared when they burnt the city with fire. *Joshua 6:1-27; Hebrews 11:31*
7. A woman of Samaria went to a well to draw water. There she met someone who knew that she had had five husbands and was currently living with someone to whom she was not married. Who did this woman of Samaria meet? *John 4:1-30*
8. Priscilla and her husband were Paul’s *helpers* in the early Christian church. Church services were held in their house. All three of them were tentmakers. Please name Priscilla’s husband. *Acts 18:2, 3*
